Allan Foster McCool "Al" passed away on April 4, 2019 after a short battle with cancer. Allan was a lifelong resident of Kalkaska, Michigan. He was born on October 29, 1951 to Foster and Eleanor McCool. He met and married his High School sweetheart Christine Elaine Baetz. They were together for fifty (50) years: married for forty-eight (48) years.

Allan was an avid outdoorsman. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, farming, gardening, syrup making, and mushrooming.

Allan was very proud of his work ethic which started when he was thirteen trimming Christmas trees in the summer, this led him to be a valued member of a construction crew in which he and his crew traveled all over Michigan building apartments and other structures, and finally landed him a position working with his father as an insurance agent for Farm Bureau Insurance where he worked until he retired in 2016.

Allan was full of anecdotes of family history, apt at delivering a great story with humor and drama, he was in possession of a quick wit, and a smart sense of humor.

He was a very active member of his family, as well as the community over the years he developed myriad and lasting friendships with people both in this area and around the state, and he will be missed by all.

Allan was preceded in death by his parents Foster and Eleanor McCool (both of Kalkaska).
