Andrew W. Larson, 92, of South Boardman, Michigan, passed away at home peacefully with his family on the 9th of August 2023.

He was born February 8, 1931, on his family farm in South Boardman, Michigan.

He was the son of William "Bill" and Helen (Dudley) Larson along with three sisters Caroline Nolf, Manon Hart, and Sonia Tubbs.

Andrew was a graduate of Kalkaska High School in 1948. He later joined and served in the United States Navy from 1952-1975 where he maintained and flew carrier based heavy attack aircraft (VAH) during the Cold War and Vietnam War.

While on recruiting duty in California he met the love of his life, Joy L. Wright and they married in 1960 and had two children.

He returned to South Boardman in 1975, where he worked for the State of Michigan Corrections for 15 years supervising detainees at facilities Shawano, Baraga, Pellston, and Camp Grayling.

After his final retirement he would do whatever he wanted from hunting, fishing, trapping, gold panning and taking care of his family.

He will be missed by his son Stephen (Ardeith) Larson, daughter Marie (John) Lamie; four grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, along with many other family members, and great friends.
