Angela M. Cleveland, age 88, passed away peacefully at Munson Hospice House in Traverse City on September 4, 2011. Cleveland, Jr. on October 22, 1942. They made their home in Detroit, MI., until September 1964 and then they had a new home built in Livonia, MI. Angie loved her dog Corky. She worked at the Feblo Company in Livonia until she retired at the age of 65. Angie's nick name while working for Feblo's was "#1 packer" as she always worked hard for the parts division and kept the packing line on task! Her retirement home was built by Otto in Oliver Township, Kalkaska, Michigan. Angie was an active member of the Town and Country Helping Hands of Oliver Township for many years and she was a member of the "Women of the Moose" in Graying. She enjoyed many activities through out the years, baking, fishing for walleyes with family, tying quilts, playing euchre, but she really enjoyed visiting with dear friends and family. She had an infectious smile and a pleasant personality which will be missed

by all who knew her. Angie is survived by her husband of 68 years who she called "Spencer", her daughter, Norma (Spencer), daughter-in-law Bonnie, granddaughters, Julie, Christine and Alison (Brian), and great-grandson, Luke, and many other loving relatives and special friends.
