Charles “Charlie” “Squeak” Edward Todd, age 77, passed away on Saturday, August 27, 2022, peacefully at home.

He was born on July 19, 1945, to Charles Leftwich Todd and Elizabeth Ida (Ervin) Calvert in Minden, West Virginia and grew up in Oak Hill, West Virginia.

Charlie served in the United States Army from 1963 until 1966, where he spent time in Korea (DMZ) and Fort Hood Texas.
