Dennis (Fang) Neil Haynes died on Tuesday, December 5, 2023, at home surrounded by family, after a long battle with colon cancer.

Fang was born September 14, 1950, to Melvin and Thelma (Larson) Haynes. After graduating from Oxford in 1968, he went into the Marines serving in the Vietnam-Era and returning home in 1972. He worked as a welder for 40 years, but his true passion in life came with 2 wheels, and a helmet (sometimes).

Dennis was a dedicated motorcycle man for over 50 years, and road all over the United States. He rode with his brothers, and other family members faithfully, until a fall and a broken hand set him back from being able to continue his biker life.

Dennis married Kimberlee Renee Beck on January 10, 2017, following the death of his wife Shawn Miller in July 2014.

After retirement, Dennis spent his time tinkering around the house, and spending time with his family. It wasn't very often you wouldn't find him outside having a bonfire, with a Budweiser in his hand, laughing and telling stories about his biker days, and time overseas during the war.

Dennis is survived by his loving wife Kimberlee, daughter Denise (Brian) McLain, son Sam (Elizabeth) Lockey; stepdaughters Amber (Anthony) Burkett, and Nicole Edwards, stepson Chad Edwards, and eleven grandchildren, seven great grandchildren; siblings Melvin (Sandy) Haynes, Terry (Cindy) Haynes, Ruth (Doug) Pruet, and sister-in-law Juanita Haynes and brother-in-law Timothy Beck. He was also "dad" to a lot of very special

people he helped raise over the years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, beloved wife Shawn Miller, siblings Debbie, Pammy, Dee, and Chuckie, and brother Eric Coward.
