Edward L. Bole, 62, of Stockport, Ohio died Thursday afternoon, June 2, 2011 at University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor. He was born September 16, 1948, the son of Chester and Mary (White) Bole, both deceased of Stockport, Ohio. Ed graduated from Farwell High School. He enlisted in the Navy at the Great Lakes Naval Training Center in 1968. Ed served his country abroad on the USS Yosemite.
