George Sikorski, 95, a 45 year resident of Empire and formerly of Detroit, died Thursday, September 7th in Traverse City. He was born on September 20, 1921 in Detroit, to the late William and Lena (Olariu) Sikorski of Detroit. George was retired from Michigan Bell and lead an active life in construction and repair in Leelanau and Beulah Counties. Many will remember him as a long term member of the Empire Fire Department, including a stint on the Fire Board, or as the Empire Township Constable. In November 1942, he enlisted in the USCG Reserve and served in the American and Pacific Theaters of WWII. In March 1946, he was Honorably Discharged and returned to civilian life and Michigan Bell. He is survived by his son, Jay (Sindi) Sikorski of Greensboro, MD; granddaughter Rachel (Jack) Smith of Felton, DE; grandson Will Sikorski of Shelby, MI; great grandson Hudson Richardson of Shelby, MI; and niece Donna Marshall of Detroit. Preceding him in death was his wife, Ruth, and many friends and acquaintances. A memorial service will be scheduled at a later date. Memorials may be made to the Empire Area Museum.
