October 25, 1934 - July 27, 2015

Gordon Grice Dunlap died peacefully at his home on Torch Lake, Rapid City, MI on July 27, 2015. He was 80 years old. Gordon was elected to Kalkaska ASC committee 1962-1976. He was appointed to FHA 1973 for Crawford, Kalkaska, Missaukee and Roscommon counties. After retirement, Gordon and Norma volunteered with Roving Volunteers in Christ Service (RVICS) for several years. Gordon was a member of Bay Area Baptist Church of Williamsburg.
