Grace K. (Rolle) Six-Wood, 93, of South Boardman, our loving, devoted mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, passed away on Monday, April 11, 2016 at KMHC – LTC in Kalkaska. She was born on Sept. 18, 1922 in South Boardman to the late Soren Michael and Metha (Raven) Rolle, next to the youngest of their six daughters and the last survivor of their Danish family. Grace married Cleo Six on Oct. 23, 1937, and became a young widow with two children and a third on the way in Aug. 1949, when he died in a work related accident. She returned to So. Boardman with her children, Joyce, Stanley and Steve, to live with her father. He was the town blacksmith. He provided the house, but she made it a home for him and her family. Later, she had a brief marriage and her fourth child, Craig Wood. Though Grace was a humble person, she had a strong constitution that enabled her to single handedly support and care for her family, working many years in a fishing tackle factory in Traverse City. She was gentle, loving and giving, devoting her entire life to family. In 1987, she was named Kalkaska County Mother of the Year. Grace was a long time devoted and active member of the Evergreen Bible Baptist Church. In retirement, she belonged to the So. Boardman Senior Center and served as their treasurer for many years. As well as volunteering at Red Cross blood drives. Being able to spend time with her grandchildren was a cherished blessing to her. Grace was predeceased by her son, Steve Six and his wife, Chelle; and her sisters, Elna, Martha, Agnes, Helen and Helga. Grace is survived by daughter, Joyce (Jerry) Johnston; sons, Stanley
