Jan Peter Stuhlmann of Mancelona, passed away on Thursday, June 9, 2016 at home. He was 74 years old and was born on February 7, 1942 in Ann Arbor to the late Torrey and Eleanor (Bancroft) Stuhlmann. Jan entered into marriage with the former Janet Williams on July 22, 1965. The couple spent 50 plus years together. Jan graduated from Eastern Michigan University with a Master's of Art Education degree. He taught junior high art in the Cherry Hill School District in Inkster for 7 years. Together Jan and Janet homesteaded in northern Michigan where he taught pottery at Kirtland Community College and elementary school art in Mancelona. He also did numerous carpentry projects, building houses and remodeling homes. Jan was a lifelong artist, specializing in pottery. He was a Blue Lake Twp. Supervisor, and a 30-year member of the Blue Lake Twp. Fire and Rescue Squad. Jan was an avid cross-country skier, finishing second overall in the first White Pine Stampede, a 50 kilometer race which went from Frederic to Mt. Mancelona. He continued skiing in races until a few years before he had a stroke four years ago. Jan is survived by his wife, Janet; nieces, nephews; sisters-in-law and brothers-in-law.
