Jill Kimberly Macdonald, age 52, of Traverse City, MI was suddenly lost to us on Friday, August 17, 2012. Jill was born July 21, 1960 in Muskegon, MI to Richard and Jacqueline Wagner. She was adopted by her stepfather Bruce Macdonald at age 6 and lived the rest of her life as Jill Macdonald. Jill graduated from Spring Lake High School and attended Western Michigan University pursuing a degree in political science. She was a valued employee of Hagerty Insurance in Traverse City in Human Resources. She had previously been a manager at the Border's Bookstore in Traverse City and Zingerman's Delicatessen in Ann Arbor, MI. Jill was an excellent cook and relished plotting and trying new food combinations with significant-other-husband-partner-co-purchaser, Matt eagerly participating.
