The wind is starting to fill the sails, and soon it will be time to board. The sails are full, and the ship is leaving, Paul could not hold against the power of the Lord. She gave me a kiss, a big smile, an "I Love You" and waved good-bye. A celebration for Julie will be on July 30, 2016 at 2:00 PM at Paul and Julie's residence in Grawn.
