November 7, 1990 - July 31, 2015

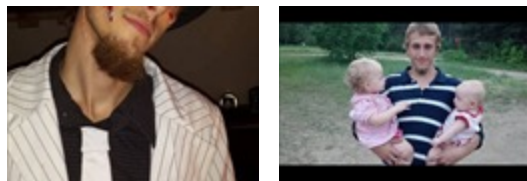
