



## Marilyn Maxine (Longcore) Schneider

Marilyn graduated Traverse City Senior High in 1954. Many a hiker has used one of her beautifully painted walking sticks adorned with colorful feathers and totems. An avid hiker herself, Pikes Peak was one of her favorite challenges. Over the years Marilyn developed a passionate interest in 19th and 20th century dinnerware, glassware and art pottery produced by some of the most skilled artisans across the country.
