



Max E. McCool

April 9, 1921 - April 26, 2014

Max Eugene McCool died April 19, 2014, with his family at his side. Max was born in the home of his parents, Amos Hersey McCool and Anna Caldwell McCool, in Oliver Township on April 9, 1921. Max has three siblings, Foster McCool of Kalkaska, Eleanor McCool Van Zyll of Grand Rapids, and Rex McCool of Delton, all still living. Max was married to Joyce Louise Ingleright McCool in June 1950. They were married nearly 60 years, until her death in April 2010. Max and Joyce had 5 children: Max Douglas McCool, stillborn; Paul (Debbie) McCool, of Overland Park, KS; Mark (Robin) McCool, of Kalkaska; Steven (Peggy) McCool, of Marianna, FL; and Nancy (Scott) McCool Luca, of Kalkaska. In addition to their 5 children, Max and Joyce had 10 grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren. Max grew up on the family farm and continued to operate the farm after his father's retirement. He later was employed as a custodian at the Cherry Street Elementary School in Kalkaska, where he was much loved by a generation of students. Max was an active member of the Spencer Church of Christ, where he and Joyce raised their children. Max was also instrumental in establishing the Wilderness Christian Service Camp by donating land for the camp's facilities and by serving in a variety of roles over the years. In addition, Max was active in civic affairs as a township assessor and member of the Oliver Township Board. Max will be remembered for his capacity to love and be loved, for his quiet and generous nature, for his hard work and for his integrity. Most of all, he will be remembered as Dad, as Grandpa, as brother and uncle and cousin and
