Patricia Ann Stanton, of Kalkaska, went home to the Lord on February 10th, 2025, at the age of 82. She was born on May 18th, 1942, in Mount Clemens, MI to the late Aloysius and Malvine (Paternoster) Urbin. Growing up in East Detroit, Pat attended St. Veronica Grade School and graduated from Regina High School, a Roman Catholic Preparatory School for girls in 1960. She retired from the Ford Motor Company in Detroit in 1998 and retired in Northern Michigan on Big Twin Lake in Mancelona.
