Ruth K. Taylor, 84 of Traverse City died Sunday, December 15, 2013 at Munson Hospice House with her immediate family at her side. She was born on October 14, 1929 in Indianapolis to Elmer and Ruth (Strasburger) Homrighausen, and was reared in both Indianapolis and Princeton N.J. Ruth graduated with a BA from the College of Wooster in 1954 and received her Masters in Library Science from U of M a few years later. She married Mac Taylor on August 28, 1952.
