Vincent "Jim" DiRosa, age 78, passed away at his home in Mancelona on Monday, February 10, 2014. He was born on July 20, 1935 in Detroit to Frank and Julianna (Sav) DiRosa.

Jim met the love of his life, Judith Alma Ponder, on a blind date in the fall of 1956. After a whirlwind 6 month romance, they were married in East Detroit on May 18, 1957.

Jim proudly served his country as a member of the United States Army. He was a Detroit police officer for 10 years before moving to the Mancelona area in 1967.
